Enrolment	<p>It is a requirement that all students are enrolled full-time (3 to 4 units each semester) Students should seek pre-approval from their home university for any unit they wish to undertake at UTAS before or after arrival Student can choose approximately 8 appropriate level units for pre-approval as not all units will be available. Finalisation of enrolment will take place during orientation week</p>
Credit System	<p>1 x UTAS 12.5% = 7.5 ECTS per unit (Europe) 1 x UTAS 12.5% = 3 to 4 credits (US)</p>

English Language requirements	<p><u>Undergraduate requirements (1 of the following is required):</u> IELTS 6.00 (no band less than 5.5) TOEFL 550/TWE 4.5 (paper-based) 80 with no score below 20 (internet-based) DAAD B in all areas (this must not be more than 2 years old) 10/gut in English at Abitur, Fachhochschulreife, Zeugnis der Allgemeine Hochschulreife or Reifezeugnis Letter from International Office confirming student's English Language Proficiency to be equal to one of the above.</p> <p>Education, Teaching, Human Movement and Nursing units require an IELTS score of 7 (no band less than 6.5).</p>
